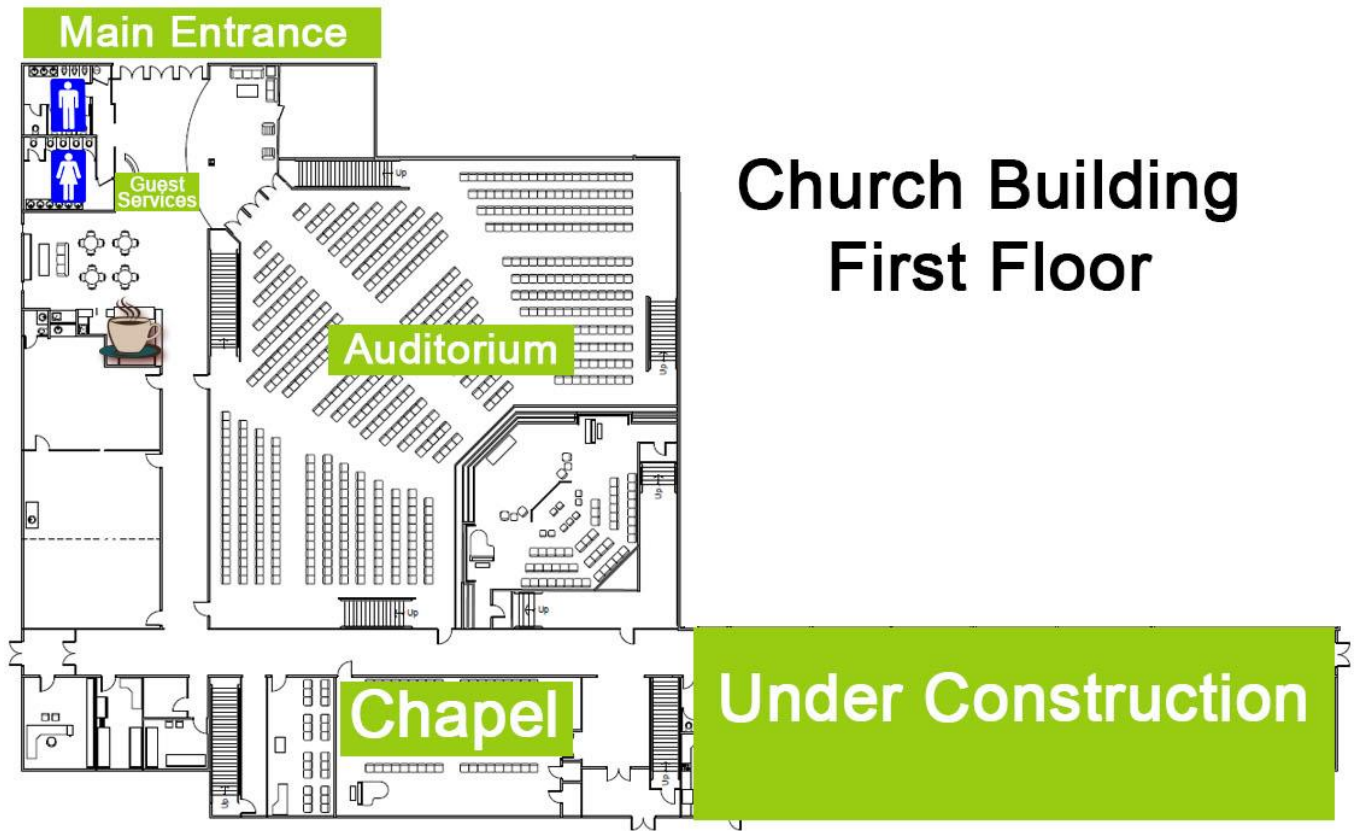
Getting to the Root of Academic and Behavior Problems – Executive Function Delays

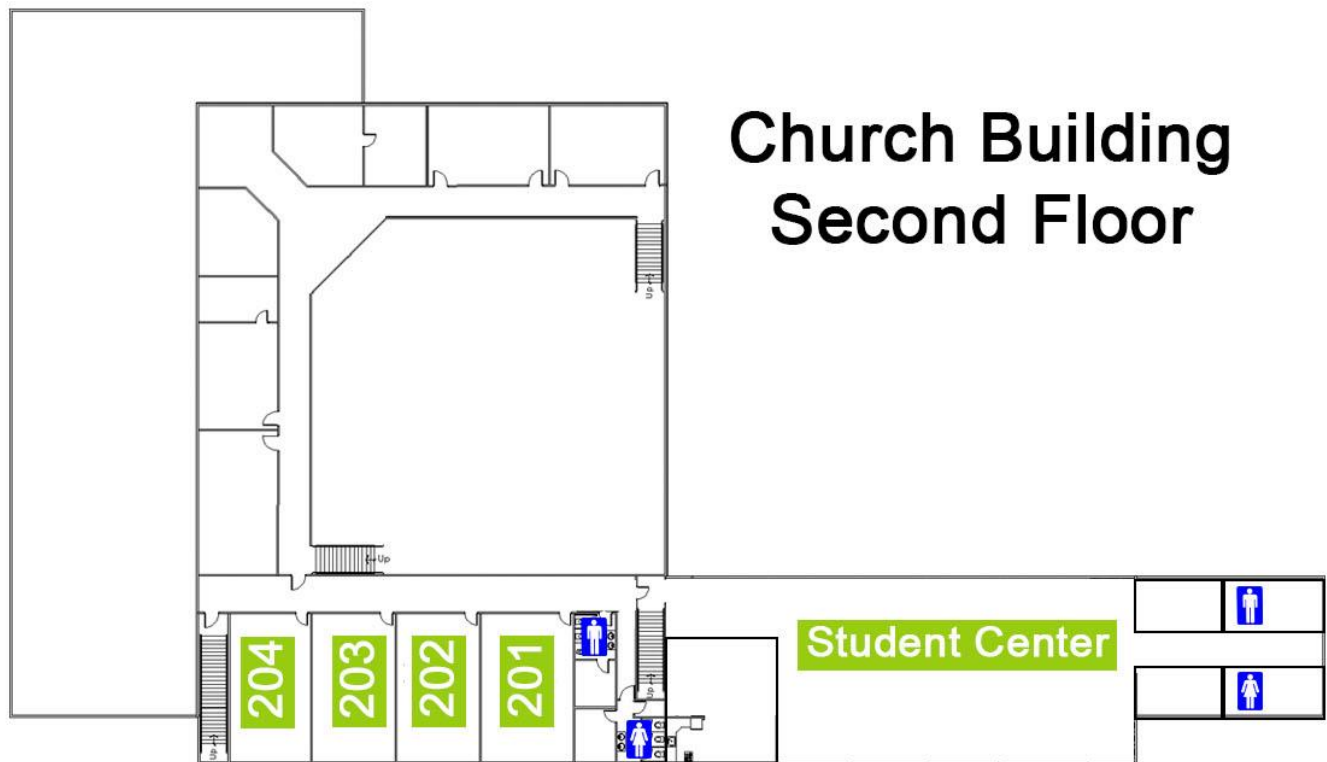
